500	Accessibility	Access for Senior, Disabled - many of the buildings are not easily accessible to those with mobility issues. Ramps could be built and installed / Grants may be available for chair lift at Landing
501	Beautification - Exterior of Buildings	Appearance of buildings and residences within the Village Core. Have clean up challenges, encourage owners to 'spruce up'. Paint a fresh face on existing structures. Medical Centre - Little Library. First Impressions
502	Beautification - Landscape	Ideas said plant trees or shrubs - What about planters along the street? Existing ones by Mercantile and Community Bulletin board could be revitalized. Clean up area garden's with the help of the Garden Club.
503	BUS Transportation	Contact Kings Transit, the Municipality of Clare and even Transport de Clare to assess the feasibility of a S/W Bus along the French Shore to Yarmouth and back
504	Café / Coffee Shop / Games	Although there were a number of ideas regarding a café, we need to first see if we can encourage (incentivize) the Diner (or the Mercantile).
505	Community Gardens	Community Gardens / Raised Beds / Farmer's Market - Dedicated area of land for rental for gardens. Sold at Farmers Market or Surplus given to local food bank / How to Demo's / Create a memorial park - School children could assist and learn about nature.
506	Community Guide	Welcome package for New and information for Existing residents - incl. info on services (plumber, carpenter, Electrician, Seamstress, disability services, recreation, etc.) as well as Organizations and volunteer opportunities / Start a Community Radio Station (FM or Internet) to communicate about what's going on in and around the village.
507	Community Services	Collaboration between Local organizations (Legion / Lions, etc.) - instead of 5 diff. meetings should be 1 combined for the good of Weymouth,
508	Develop Waterfront / River	Tide Pole to show range of water level. Could incorporate a feature of the area (Owls, etc.), Have a Boardwalk or walking trail along riverbank, Boat Tours along Sissiboo, Eagle Feeding Station / Deck or wharf on the upper side of the bridge with seating / place to fish from / launch Kayaks / Move Little Library bldg. from Weymouth North to Dock area.
509	Education	Speakers / Workshops - Dancing, Sewing, Art, Area History, Budgeting, University topics, Tablesaping, Sign Language, Boat Building / BEARS-Little Library boxes, / Programs and exposure tor new graduates and skilled persons / U3A Group / Fitness + Senior /
510	Environmental	Styrofoam recycling, Bottle depot (recycling), Available water and dumping Station for RV's
511	Farmer's/Craft Market	Pave behind shops - add tables, stalls, toilets - hold trunk sales, markets (Or use Storybook Trail) Have on Sunday afternoon to not compete. Start with a couple of permanent stalls and expand as needed. Produce from Gardens could be sold.
512	Health / Medical	Need more Doctors, have support groups at the Medical Centre, Create a Wellness Centre - Osteo, Massage, Naturopath, Alt. Med. , Mental Health, Services for disabled
513	Improved Internet	There is a provincial initiative to increase the infrastructure to provide access to High Speed internet to more of the province. There were a couple of requests for Village -Wide wi-fi.
514	LAW and By-Law Enforcement	More RCMP presence in village. Keep Vehicles off sidewalks, discourage drinking/smoking on sidewalks. Require owner's of downtown buildings to maintain appearance. Enforce existing bylaws
515	MISCELLANEOUS	Sell Lots for a nominal fee to encourage people to move to the area. Incentives for existing real estate to encourage purchase. / A pet Store (already have Jubin's Aquarium) / Conference Centre or Community Centre - Multi-phase, multi-use project - Stage / Camp / Retreat / Lodge / Solar Panel Farm / A mall with a Dollar Store, a Costco and a small restaurant like Swiss Chalet. /Fast Food Chain - Arby's Wendy's Burger King, Mary Browns / Dedicated Toy Store / Access to Audio/Video/Editing media for production of online (web-based) content possibly to create revenue for online content./ Phone Charging Stations - Landing, Storybook, Bandstand

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516	New France	Develop Interpretive site, Grow the Tour de New France to a Tri-athlon, better signage to location, "building some original looking bldgs./ Workers in period costume / "day in the life" activities / Guided trails" / Build a place where plays can be performed in town.
517	Outdoor - surrounding area	Fish Ladder at Weymouth Falls (First Dam) / Dredge the riverbed between Weymouth Bridge and Gates' Bridge / Tidal Power Sissiboo River / Look out on 'the Loop' in New Edinburgh or Fort Point - Signage in town to indicate / Acquire a 'novascotiawebcam' pointed to 'where the river meets the sea' / Community BBQ - build a permanent BBQ pit / Leash free - Dog Park / Fitness Park / Bike Lanes
518	Outdoor - Village	Turn area where Bell store was into a Garden or Picnic area, Boardwalk in front of Mercantile (like western Saloon) / Trap Door on outlet to Salt Water (flood prevention) / Show and Shine - Car show / Community use for Village Land - solicit ideas for use of "the Gulley". Land is already owned by the village, could be oval running track / open ice surface in winter / Community Centre / Open air Swimming pool - This idea could tie in with splash pad, waterslide.
519	Safety	Fix Sidewalks, Potholes, Pave behind shops, speed bumps, Add Speed sign, refurb Gates' Lane Bridge
520	Seniors' Accomodation	More affordable housing for Seniors who may sell a large home but wish to stay in the area. Could also accommodate students although Weymouth might be a distance to Ste. Anne (without adequate transit). Also, development of a full care/assisted living facility with amenities (internet, gathering rooms, etc.) Also, games/activity centre / Establish a chapter of "Elder dog" organisation (http://www.elderdog.ca/) - to connect with people with pets who may need assistance in their pet care.
521	Sissiboo Landing	Update interior - Open year round, same hrs. as Library / Move around static displays / Change layout / encourage interaction / Merchandise upstairs / Create programs, talks, presentations / Backgrnd music / Refreshment station / internet access / Add more Black History info / Pictorial History of Stores, etc. / Add flag to message board
522	Things for Younger persons	Get Youth committee 'what direction does the Village want to take?' (thru Social Media) / Virtual Reality Room (ride a rollercoaster, climb a mountain, etc.) / Construct a splash pool (or waterslide) on the waterfront / Drop in center (moms & tots) / Indoor Kids center: so any day of the week or rainy or stormy days they can come and play through an obstacle course and or games. / Movie in the park: two nights a week Friday and Saturday nights where you can come out as a community and watch movies under the stars. / Escape Rooms / Street Dances
523	Tourism - Tours	Area Tours, Graveyard Tours, Walking Guide - Historic homes, Artist Studio, ATV Tours, Hiking, Fishing, Local Cuisine, Eco-Tourism, Boat Tours / For the summer months on the river have a tubing staging where folks can come purchase bathing suits, beach towels, beach balls, umbrellas sand toys. ideally a shop where one can come in and see all the summer apparel.
524	Use of Existing Facilities	alternate uses for Mink Farms - could raise Angora Rabbits / grow barley, hops for Micro Brewery (see Weymouth Water) / Encourage Smaller Business esp. to replace Mink farms / Anaerobic digester in Weaver Settlement - how to get up and running again?
525	Use of Existing Buildings	More exposure for local artists & photographers - local art at Historical Society / Bakery - already proven to be successful here / Sissiboo Place - Improve the overall condition. Find uses for the vacant spaces. Focus group on bringing business into town. / Crafty Corner Consignment - could rent space and sell local crafts, offer instructional courses, Art Show / Photography Group / Gardening Group
526	Weymouth Water	Weymouth should own and be in control of the water at the fountain. Rights could be "leased" only. Partner up with whoever owns the existing plant. Rebuild area around fountain to make safer and accessible. Also, could become a micro-brewery (barley grown on unused mink ranch lands)
